

## **Rear TV upgrade**

The original 20 inch standard TV was removed including all the bracketing used to hold it in place.

I replaced it with a Samsung 27 inch LED flat screen, model 2770HD. Some of the main features that attracted me to this TV with the low power consumption, 59 W, and the overall weight, 18 lbs. That's besides being HDMI compatible with a digital audio output.

To mount the TV bracketed to the original front molding and built a single upright to support the rear, basically the TV sits on the swing out shelf cushioned on a foam pad.

The HDMI input originates from the front home theater matrix, and the antenna is directly connected to the line amplifier. The spare input and output are connected to the rear Sony Home Theater surround sound system, which six DVD playback.
