

Side TV upgrade

The original 19 inch standard TV was removed including all the pullout -- slide bracketing used to hold it in place.

I replaced it with a Sony 32 inch LED flat screen, model KDL-32EX600. Some of the main features that attracted me to this TV with the low power consumption, 85 W, and the overall weight, 25 lbs. That's besides being HDMI compatible with a digital audio output.

No mounting was required for this TV, it basically is on the original stand. A black felt curtained was placed behind the TV to hide the additional storage area created by replacing the original equipment.

The HDMI input originates from the front home theater matrix, and the antenna is directly connected to the line amplifier. The spare output is connected to the side stereo system.
