

Window Awnings Addition

The RV did not come with awnings or very dark tinted windows, I find on a sunny day the heat becomes intolerable inside. After spending a week boon docking in the middle of an open field this summer with temperatures hovering around 100° I decided to install awnings.

I purchased two(2) 66 inch and a 48 inch window awning from the "RV WorkShop" for a total of little under \$600.00. (Overhangs about 4 inches on either side of the window)

The very simple to install, mount them about 4 inches above the window drill holes and use the screws supplied to mount them into the side wall, pulling down stretch out the straps and mount the hold down brackets. Note, a complete set of instructions come with each awning.

I'm very happy with the results, cuts the heat down immensely and a very simple to bring down and up, I leave them up when it's cold out to heat the inside of the RV on a sunny day and pull them down as the day gets hot.
