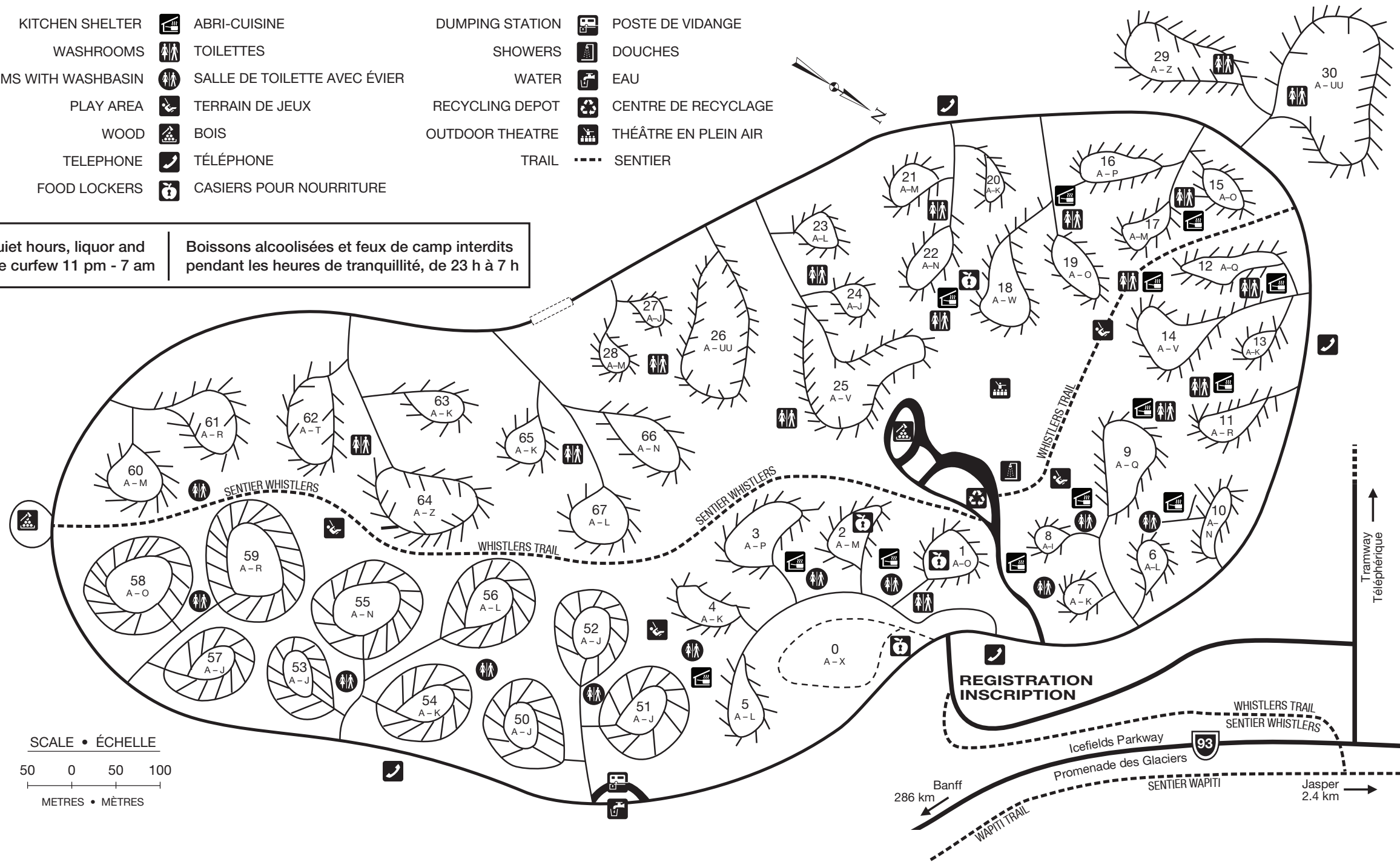

Recycling containers are available in every washroom for:

- cardboard, boxboard
- newsprint, paper, magazines
- aluminum, glass food jars
- plastics Nos. 1, 2, 5, (no film or Styrofoam)
- propane cylinders
- batteries
- all beverage containers

Beverage containers (liquor, beer, dairy, juice, soft drinks) can also be placed in the outdoor metal blue bins.

Campgrounds

These facilities are provided for visitors seeking an enjoyable national park camping experience. They provide a base for visitors to explore other areas of the park. Please help us keep these natural areas enjoyable places to stay by co-operating in the following ways:

- Keep vehicles and camping equipment within the designated site.
- One vehicle and one sleeping unit per site.
- Bears and other wildlife live in the area and are attracted to food odours. Place garbage in bins. Avoid cooking inside tents and tent trailers. All food supplies, including coolers, must be stored in your vehicle.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Visitors, liquor and fires are not permitted during this time.
- Use of generators is limited to the following time slots: 8:00–9:30 am and 5:00–7:00pm.
- For the safety of both pets and wildlife, pets must be leashed and never left unattended.
- Check-out and re-registration time is 11:00 am.
- Maximum length of stay is 14 days.
- In the event of extreme winds, it is recommended that you move to an open area, away from the risk of falling trees.
