

Wastewater Hose Supports

We found ourselves in the campground where the wastewater connections were quite a distance from our coach and above the level ground. The standard wastewater hose supports would not suffice, which would mean the hoses would have to be laid on the ground and manually emptied by lifting the hose along its length. This we found to be unacceptable, and a solution had to be found.

The simplest solution was to purchase 10' of 4" plastic drain pipe, 20' of 1/2" schedule 80 plastic pipe, (20) 1/2" pipe 'T's, and plastic hangers. By cutting the 10' 4" plastic drainpipe in half both lengthwise and in half, we ended up with (4) 5' sections, creating almost 20' of support. Next by cutting the 1/2" plastic pipe and using the 'T's as shown in the picture we are able to create five supports of various heights.

This solution works very well for under \$25, plus the pipes and supports were easily disassembled and stored for another location.
