1000.2 Satellite Antenna

Replaced our original Dish Network 500 Plus with a 1000.2 Satellite Antenna, the increase satellite coverage was well worth the effort. We selected the 'West Arc' because it covers most of the US, except the far north east. The only problem is that Dish Network has a problem assigning satellite hits for east coast locations (they prefer you use an East Arc so they don't have to force a 129 satellite hit in place of the 67 satellite hit, but any tech can do it for you).

Nice to have over 200 channels, most in high definition, with all the local channels for about \$70 a month (state tax differs).

Note: We move every week during the summer, so setting up three satellites is a real bummer sometimes but well worth the time. We use the free smart phone application 'Satellite AR' which gives you a picture of the required satellites though the rear camera, a great check for location and obstructions when setting up.
