WiFi Instructions and Troubleshooting Guide

General Instructions

There are two WiFi networks available for public use. When you go to connect to WiFi it is best to wait 5-10 seconds to ensure both networks are found by your device. You will either see one network, **wekiva-fi2**, or two networks, **wekiva-fi** and **wekiva-fi2**. If you see both networks, you should choose **wekiva-fi** and try using that. If this network is slow, or if you only see one network, then you should try **wekiva-fi2**.

Connecting Guide

- **Android Devices**

1. Press the **Home** button, and then press the **Apps** button. Navigate to **Settings**.
2. Under "Wireless and Networks", make sure "Wi-Fi" is turned on, then press **Wi-Fi**.
3. You may have to wait a moment as your Android device detects wireless networks in range, and displays them in a list.
4. Press the Wi-Fi network name that you want to connect to.
5. If the Android device reports that it has successfully connected to the wireless network, but you still cannot access the Internet reboot your device and try again.

- **Apple Devices**

1. From your Home screen, go to Settings > Wi-Fi.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi.
Your device will automatically search for available Wi-Fi networks.
3. Tap the name of the Wi-Fi network that you want to join.
4. After you join the network, you'll see ✓ next to the network and  in the upper-left corner of your display.

- **Laptops and Desktops**

1. Make sure your device supports WiFi and click on the WiFi icon. There should be an icon in the top-right of the screen that looks like  or in the bottom-right corner that looks like 
2. Wait for your device to scan for WiFi networks and click on the appropriate network

Troubleshooting

If you are having trouble loading webpages and playing video, then please try these steps.

- If you can see both networks, try switching to the other one.
- Make sure you are on the correct router by turning off WiFi for a few seconds and turning it back on and waiting 5-10 seconds. Some devices may require a restart.
- Does the WiFi work outside but not inside? Try using the WiFi indoors by the window and see if it works better. If it does, you may want to consider getting a repeater from the Office.
- If a certain App or website isn't working properly, try using another App or website. There may be an issue with just that App or website.
- You can safely ignore any security warning saying the WiFi network is not secure since this only applies to home routers. You are connecting to a secure public WiFi network.
